Effective January 1, 2019 Membership Fees are as follows:

Golf: The basic golf membership fee will change from \$ 200.00 to \$300.00 annually. Membership includes golf for those *living* in the household. Members will then pay cart fee every time they play, unless walking which is included in the membership. Walking is authorized Monday through Friday and after 3:00 p.m. on weekends and holidays. Members may also be able to purchase 10 play cards for \$100.00 which gives \$40.00 in savings. Exclusions: Adult children not residing in the household or Adults who reside in the household and are not being financially dependent on the member, will be require to have a separate membership.

Pool: In the past, the pool membership has been confusing to some of the members. In order to clarify this, with the exception of Full members, the pool membership will be a Pool Pass for the season due before the pool opens, Memorial day weekend through Labor day. The Pool Pass will change from \$300.00 to \$400.00 for a family of 4. Additional members of the family residing in the home will be an additional fee of \$100.00 per person per year. To clarify these changes, in the past there were dual families residing in the home and paying only one fee. Additionally, The costs to open the pool, with inspection, repairs and maintenance have risen. Continued.....
